Application Form for Scholarship Audition

The Lindsay Concert Foundation is now receiving audition applications for the Bursary Trust Fund, Junior and Intermediate Scholarship Awards. These are two cash awards made annually to candidates who meet the following criteria:

- 1 The individual must plan to further his/her musical education;
- 2a **Junior:** The individual must be at least 12 years of age and under 16 years of age at the date of the application deadline.
- 2b The individual must perform at a minimum of Grade 6 RCM to be eligible for the Junior Award.
- 3a **Intermediate:** The individual must be at least 16 years of age and under 21 years of age, and not yet enrolled in a university or college program at the date of the application deadline.
- 3b The individual must perform at a minimum of Grade 8 RCM in order to be eligible for the Intermediate Award
- 4 The individual must be ordinarily resident within the boundaries of the City of Kawartha Lakes in the Province of Ontario, at least one year prior to the application deadline.
- 5 The individual must have demonstrated talent, dedication, and perseverance.
- 6 The individual who received a previous award in one category is eligible to apply to the next age level category. No Bursary award recipient shall receive any further award in a specific award category, having been a past recipient in a specific award category.

(RCM* means Royal Conservatory of Music)

Applications will be received until March 1st

Note: The deadline moves to the next business day, should March 1st fall on a weekend or statutory holiday. Completed application and all support material are to be postmarked by Canada Post or a courier company on or before the deadline date – March 1st.

Auditions will be held the last Saturday in April at Sir Sandford Fleming College.

(Audition date and facility are subject to change due to availability and instrument need.)

The annual Bursary Trust Fund, Scholarship awards will be awarded at the first concert of the Lindsay Concert Foundation season.

Please assist the Foundation by encouraging anyone who would be eligible to apply in writing, to complete the following application with pertinent information and to provide at least one written reference.

A completed application package will consist of the following:

- A **non-refundable registration fee of \$25.00** payable to Lindsay Concert Foundation, Bursary Trust Fund
- **Three (3) copies** of the completed Application
- **Three (3) copies of Teacher Reference Form** must be received by March 1st
